The previous affidavit did not reveal the correct phone number used to call the victim nor did it fully explain why the defendant was at the residence. This affidavit will correct those errors.

On 12/31/19 at approximately 0708 hours AST responded to 8365 N. Tongass Hwy. for a report of a house fire. Initial
reports from witnesses at the scene were that no persons were in the residence and it was only used for storage by the
owner, Further investigation revealed Kami Riley (residence listed in APSIN is 8365 N. Tongass
Hwy) was seen near the scene of the fire when it was first noticed by prior to the residence being fully engulfed
in flames. stated Riley was pounding on his door early this morning yelling that she was going to "burn his house
down." explained Riley used to live there but doesn't anymore. At 0726 hours right after dropping Kami Riley of
at Safeway called Dispatch stating he had picked Kami Dawn Riley up approximately 400 feet from the
scene of the fire and given her a ride. explained Riley stated "that guy got what he deserved" concerning the
