On 7/2/20, officers of the Ketchikan Police Department, with the assistance of the United States Postal Inspection Service, the Federal Bureau of Investigations, and the Alaska State Trooper Drug Detection K9 unit conducted an investigation into the importation of Methamphetamine and Cocaine into Ketchikan. A shipment containing approximately 237.7 grams of suspected Methamphetamine and 3.9 grams of suspected Cocaine was intercepted en-route to Ketchikan. The investigation resulted in search warrants being executed at a Park Avenue residence where the defendant was living.

Based on that investigation Anthony J. Love (27 years of age from Ketchikan) was arrested and charged with two counts of Misconduct Involving a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree for possessing Methamphetamine and Cocaine with the intent to distribute. He was transported to the Ketchikan Correctional Center where he was booked accordingly and held without bail. Mr. Love was arraigned on 7/3/20 and set to be released on his own recognizance.
