As most of you are aware an employee at KCS did test positive for COVID-19 yesterday and I want to reassure you all that we have been working closely with Public Health last night and today for direction as we move forward. At this time the building has been disinfected by Alaska Pest Control and the custodial staff performed a deep cleaning of the building. The majority of our staff will return to work tomorrow, Wednesday, September 2, 2020.

Today KCS staff and district staff have been working to prepare a plan for what is next for us at KCS. After discussions with the district Superintendent, Mrs. Lougee, and Public Health officials we have decided to move the KCS start date later next week. You will be hearing from your child's teacher in the next few days with the needed details about your child's start date.
