Probable Cause Statement: On 2/10/2022 Alaska State Trooper Investigator Lander Simmers applied for a search warrant for room #102 at building #18 on Creek Street through the Ketchikan Courts for Frederick D. Lauth III DOB: 05/20/1991, Controlled substances including fentanyl pills, Evidence of Intent to distribute controlled substances, including ledgers, notebooks, scales, baggies, cash, Evidence of using Illegal drugs including foils, tooter straws, pipes, burned spoons, hypodermic needles.

Search warrant 1KE-22-26 was granted and the search warrant was exicuted on the hotel room.

A search of the room located Lauth. Addtionally over \$25,000 worth of U.S currency, 2 Electronic scales, fresh dime baggies, 12 white pills with the imprint 54 24 which was identified as Methadone Hydrochoride), 24 blue M/30 pills which based on the current drug scene in Ketchikan are counterfiet and contain fentynal, a baggie of a brown tar like substance weighing .8 grams that field tested postive for heroin, 3 white pills with an imprint of M4 which identifies

as Hydromorphone Hydrocloride. The items located during the exicution of the search warrant are indicative of the sale and distrubution of illegal controlled substances.

Lauth was read and advised of his Miranda Rights in which he waived and agreed to speak with us. Lauth admitted that he imports large quanties of meth, heroin and "blue" (counterfiet M/30 pills) Lauth admitted that the foot traffic at the hotel were individuals that he had been selling pills to. Lauth advised that the money was a collection from the drug sales and was going to sent to Seattle soon.
