## Initiative Resolution Language:

### A Resolution of the Assembly of the Ketchikan Gateway Borough Repealing the Borough's Adoption of Nonareawide Library Powers and Providing for Voter Ratification

#### RECITALS

- A. **WHEREAS**, the Assembly received a citizen petition in August, 1985 requesting that a ballot question be placed on the municipal election ballot proposing the adoption of nonareawide library powers by the Borough; and
- B. **WHEREAS**, though the petition was of uncertain sufficiency at that time, the Assembly adopted Resolutions 632, 633, and 634 in response and placed the question on the ballot for the October 1, 1985, election; and
- C. **WHEREAS**, the ballot proposition was approved by the voters by a 475-217 margin, with the votes from the City of Saxman having been mistakenly included; and
- D. **WHEREAS**, since adoption of the nonareawide library powers, the Borough has provided funding to the City of Ketchikan by way of a millage tax levied on all taxable properties located outside of the City of Ketchikan and the City of Saxman; and
- E. **WHEREAS**, the Borough has received a request from Borough residents to discontinue the exercise of a nonareawide library power and to place on the October 4, 2022 ballot a ballot proposition seeking repeal of the Borough's adoption of nonareawide library powers.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ABOVE FACTS, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KETCHIKAN GATEWAY BOROUGH AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The Ketchikan Gateway Borough's adoption of a nonareawide library power is hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** **Voter Ratification Required.** That the following question shall be placed on the ballot at the Regular Election of October 4, 2022, to be voted on by the duly qualified registered voters of the Borough who are registered to vote outside of the City of Ketchikan and the City of Saxman, and who are voting on the question:

#### "NONAREAWIDE LIBRARY POWERS

Shall the Ketchikan Gateway Borough's adoption of nonareawide library powers be repealed?

**Section 3.** **Severability.** If any provision of this resolution or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of this resolution and application thereof to any person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

**Section 4.** **Effective Date.** Section 1 of this ordinance becomes effective January 1, 2024, on the condition that a majority of nonareawide borough voters ratify the proposition set out in Section 2 of this resolution. Section 2 becomes effective immediately upon adoption of this resolution.

# Notice to Petition Signers

As a signer on this petition:

1. Your signature must be in **ink**.
2. Your printed name must be legible.
3. You must show a legible residence address.
4. You must be a qualified borough voter which means you must be a registered voter, and you must reside in the Ketchikan Gateway Borough in the area outside the City of Saxman or the City of Ketchikan.
5. The voter registration number and mailing address are to assist in checking the validity of your signature.

**The following are deemed to be adequate residence addresses:**

- ❖ A subdivision name with a lot and block number;
- ❖ A United States Survey number when the smallest recorded subdivision which is applicable to the property is included;
- ❖ A milepost when accompanied by a road or highway name;
- ❖ A boat harbor or marina name when the stall, slip or boat name is also included;
- ❖ A hotel or motel if the room number is included;
- ❖ A trailer court if the space number or street name and number within the trailer court is given;
- ❖ A house number with a street or highway name;
- ❖ An apartment or condominium name when accompanied by an apartment or unit number.

**The following types of addresses are inadequate as a residence address:**

- ❖ A street name without a house number;
- ❖ A milepost without a highway or road name;
- ❖ A highway or road name without a milepost or house number;
- ❖ Alaska, Ketchikan Gateway Borough, Ketchikan, City of Ketchikan, City of Saxman, Saxman, North Tongass, South Tongass, or any other similar designation by a geographical area or subdivision only;
- ❖ A rural route box number
- ❖ A post office box number;
- ❖ A street, highway or road intersection;
- ❖ Any address which is ambiguous either on its face or becomes ambiguous upon consulting a map or plat to which one would be led from the resident address information;
- ❖ An illegal address

**SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED INITIATIVE:** The proposed resolution, if ratified by the voters, would repeal the Borough's nonareawide library powers. Repeal of the nonareawide library powers would cause the Borough to discontinue the agreement with the City of Ketchikan to provide funding for library services, which is currently funded by a millage tax levied on all taxable properties located outside of the City of Ketchikan and the City of Saxman. If the proposition passes, the effective date of the repeal of the nonareawide library powers would be January 1, 2024.




- D. **WHEREAS**, since adoption of the nonareawide library powers, the Borough has provided funding to the City of Ketchikan by way of a millage tax levied on all taxable properties located outside of the City of Ketchikan and the City of Saxman; and
- E. **WHEREAS**, the Borough has received a request from Borough residents to discontinue the exercise of a nonareawide library power and to place on the October 4, 2022 ballot a ballot proposition seeking repeal of the Borough's adoption of nonareawide library powers.

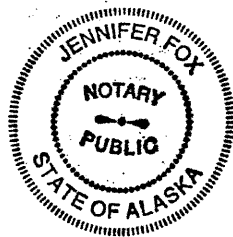

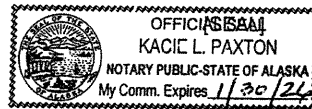
