THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT I

That in the First Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about February 17, 2023, at or near Ketchikan, MICHAEL D DAVIS possessed with intent to manufacture or deliver any amount of a schedule IIA or IIIA controlled substance; methamphetamine.

All of which is a class B Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.71.030(a)(9) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

1 The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of
2 police report AK23016571 submitted to date.

3 On February 15, 2023, the Southeast Alaska Cities Against Drugs (SEACAD)
4 Taskforce was contacted by Alaska State Trooper Casey Hershberger regarding
5 information he had received about narcotics being imported into Alaska through the
6 Alaska Marine Highway Ferry System. In essence the source alleged that **Miles Martin**
7 had provided over ten pounds of methamphetamine to a male who was currently on his
8 way up from Washington to Alaska. Based on the information provided by Sgt.
9 Hershberger and the ferry manifest provided by Coast Guard Special Agent Tim Burman,
10 SEACAD investigators were able to determine that **Michael Davis** was currently on the
11 AMHS M/V Columbia and affiliated with Martin. Further investigation revealed that
12 Davis was a walk on passenger meaning he did not have a vehicle associated with him.
13 Davis had rented stateroom 151A for his voyage and was schedule to travel from
14 Bellingham WA to Juneau AK. On February 17, 2023, at about 7:00 a.m. AST Inv.
15 Lander Simmers and KPD. Sgt. Mike Purcell observed the ferry pull into port in
16 Ketchikan, one of the many stops on the way to Juneau. During this time they did not
17 observe Davis to exit the ferry.

18 A search warrant to search the person of Davis and his stateroom was applied
19 and granted through the Ketchikan Courts. Reference **1KE-23-51SW** for further details.
20 At about 9:30 a.m. SEACAD investigators went onto the M/V Columbia and contacted
21 Davis in his state room. During the execution of the search warrant investigators located
22 18 individual packages concealed in tortillas in a blue duffle bag. Inside the packages
23 SEACAD investigators located what appeared to be a white crystalline substance which
24 field tested positive for methamphetamine using the TRUNARC Narcotic Analyzer. The
25 total gross weight (substance plus the one layer of food saving bags) of these packages
26 was 20.54 LB. Davis was the sole occupant in the state room and items located in the
27 room confirmed he was staying in it.

Further investigation revealed the methamphetamine had been sourced in
Oregon to be delivered to Juneau, Alaska. The street value associated with the quantity of
